

1	Any attendees including players, team management, officials, volunteers, spectators showing symptoms of COVID-19	Players, Team management, Officials, Volunteer committee members, Matchday Volunteers, Spectators	Medium	<ol> <li>Anyone showing signs of symptoms or who resides in the same household as someone displaying symptoms including:</li> <li>Fever (a high temperature above 37.8°C)</li> <li>A new continuous cough</li> <li>A loss or change to sense of smell or taste must not attend the ground/venue and must follow the government guidelines for self-isolation.</li> <li>Anyone who has been advised by the NHS test and trace service to isolate/quarantine must not attend the ground/venue. Players must inform the team manager and COVID-19 officer if they have been contacted by the NHS service and advised to isolate/quarantine.</li> <li>If anyone becomes symptomatic during the event, they should immediately remove themselves from the venue and return home. <u>NHS Guidance</u> on further management of symptoms to be followed.</li> </ol>	A record must be kept of anyone reporting symptoms A record must be kept of any attendees from the opposing team including the matchday officials.
